

## Definition of Classes

- “A” **Puppy** For dogs not less than six (6) months and not exceeding twelve (12) Months of age on the day of the show.
- “B” **Junior** For dogs not less than twelve (12) months and not exceeding Eighteen (18) months of age on the day of the show.
- “C” **Limit** For dogs that have not won three (3) Challenge Certificates under Three (3) different judges.
- “D” **Open** All dogs.

Note: The word “dog” above refers to both dogs and bitches

(1) Cocker Spaniel (2) Labrador Retriever (3) Weimaraner
- (f) **Working Group (Pastoral)**  
(1) Belgian Sheepdog (Groendael) (2) Bouvier Des Flanders. (3) Collie (Rough).  
(4) German Shepherd Dog (5) Welch Corgi. (6) Shetland Sheepdog
- (g) **Working Group**  
(1) Boxer (2) Bullmastiff (3) Doberman Pinscher  
(4) Great Dane (5) Great Pyreneese (6) Mastiff  
(7) Rottweiler (8) Giant Schnauzer

### Show Handlers: Dress Code in Effect.

Show ring handlers are to be properly dressed. No persons wearing shorts, vests, T-shirts or slippers will be allowed in the ring. The show manager reserves the right to refuse entry into the show ring, any person breaking the dress code. Persons/dogs debarred from showing are not entitled to a refund of any kind from the club hosting the show.

### Note: In all cases dogs will be judged first, followed by bitches.

Entries in respect of breeds not listed above will be judged in strict alphabetical order in their respective groups.
